

HAProxy

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apt install haproxy

cat <FQDN>.crt chain.crt <FQDN>.key > /etc/ssl/certs/<FQDN>.pem

chmod 777 /etc/ssl/certs/<FQDN>.pem

nano /etc/haproxy/haproxy.cfg

Adjust accordingly:

```
frontend http
    bind *:80
    bind :::80
    redirect scheme https unless { ssl_fc }
    default_backend web

frontend https
    bind *:443 ssl crt /etc/ssl/certs/www.dmz.worldskills.org.pem
    bind :::443 ssl crt /etc/ssl/certs/www.dmz.worldskills.org.pem
    default_backend web

    http-response set-header via-proxy ha-prx01

backend web
    balance roundrobin
    server web01 10.1.20.31:80 check
    server web02 10.1.20.32:80 check
```

Note that: “frontend https” is only needed if https is required.

Note that: “redirect scheme https unless { ssl_fc}” is only needed if https redirection is required.

Note that: “http-response set-header via proxy ha-prx01” is only needed if the serving HAProxy server should be appended in the header.

systemctl restart haproxy
